Youth Exchange Project

24-31 March 2018



Dear participants,

The team is happy to welcome you to this wonderful youth exchange project which will take place in March, 2018 in Drobeta Turnu Severin, Romania. It will be hosted by Youthopolis (Romania). The TC will bring together 35 participants from 5 European organizations.

The training addresses 35 young people' need to develop their competences and to multiply the project's outcomes within their local communities.

Participants' countries are the following: Romania, the Netherlands, Italy, Macedonia and Poland.

What the project is about?

It is widely recognized that social exclusion produces deep and long-term damage to the living conditions, socio-economic participation, emotional life, and wealth being of young people. Different factors play important roles in producing social exclusion for young people. Poor levels of education, experiencing discrimination, monetary poverty, unemployment, living in remote geographical areas, and experiences of juvenile delinquency, are often indicated as the main factors.





We believe negative attitudes and discrimination are educated, so what we intend to do for participants in this youth exchange is: create a learning context, un-learn what they have learn, support the new learnings. Non-formal education has the power to offer opportunities for preventing and remedying social exclusion among young people.

The aim of this project is to improve the skills of 35 young people from 5 European countries in taking action against discrimination and embrace diversity by raising awareness about the boundaries that discrimination produces in young people's life.

The aim I supported by the following objectives:

- -to empower participants to reflect about their own discriminatory attitudes;
- to help participants in acting against discrimination in their own lives;
- -to support participants in identifying and breaking the stereotypes;
- to raise awareness about the importance of uniqueness of people in a diverse Europe;
- -to promote non-formal education as a means to reduce discrimination and encourage diversity;
- to support the learning process of the participants by using the key competences from Youthpass.

The project cannot single-handedly eradicate discrimination and its faces, but it will definitely change young people's attitude, broadening their opportunities, providing new experiences and challenges and bringing out of them what is best.

By using interactive and non-formal methods, the participants will become highly involved in the project and will be able to develop their own skills and practical knowledge. The training working principles are based on experiential pedagogy. Moreover, they will be motivated to continue sharing the knowledge afterwards in their home country and within their own organization.

Profile of the participant:

- -age (18-26 years old)
- -interest in Erasmus+ programme in general and youth exchange projects in particular
- -committed to be actively involved in planning, organizing, implementing of the activities of the project
- committed to disseminate the results within their organizations and to multiply the impact of the project by actively working with peer youth in their local communities
- -interested in finding solution for the identified needs in a non-formal learning context
- -minimum working level of English (B1 to C2, according to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

Priority to selection will be given to participants with fewer opportunities (cultural, geographical, economical) and/or participants at their first international experience.

The YE will be implemented in the frames of the "Erasmus+" programme of the European Commission and was financially supported by the Romanian National Agency.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE:

Arrival: 24th March, 2018 to Drobeta Turnu Severin, Romania

<u>Departure:</u> 31^h March, 2018 from **Drobeta Turnu Severin, Romania**

TRAVEL TO ROMANIA:

There are 2 options for flying to Romania: Timișoara Airport and Bucharest airport.

For those who will arrive to Traian Vuia Timișoara Airport:

From the airport you take Express bus (E4b), which makes connection from airport to central station. The price of one ticket is 2.5 lei (0.5 Euros). You need to buy the ticket from the cashier. Payment can be done either cash or with the card. In the airport hall you will find a currency exchange office.

From Timișoara Central station (Timișoara Nord) you take the train to Drobeta Turnu Severin. Here is the link to departing time from Timișoara.

The hotel is close to the station, 10 minute walk maximum.

For those who will arrive to Otopeni Bucharest Airport:

Take bus Express 780 to the Central station (Gara de Nord). There is a bus approximately every 40 minutes, from 5 am to 11 pm. The price of a ticket round way is 9 lei (2 Euro).

From the Central Station, take the train to Drobeta Turnu Severin.

The round way train ticket is around 35 Euros.

Departure:

In case the groups will arrive at approximately the same time, we will organize a private transport from the airport to the venue of the activities. The cost is 150 lei, quite expensive, but way more comfortable for the participants.

We strongly recommend you to check with the organizers the travel option you choose. Please note that the organizers will not cover any accommodation and food costs outside the project dates.

Please, check the **validity of the IDs/passports** before the departure.

TRAVEL COSTS:

The organizers will reimburse the transport expenses, according with the distance bands, after the mobility.

Participants will be reimbursed by bank transfer shortly after their return home upon presenting original tickets, invoices and boarding passes.

- Please note that travel costs of the participants should not exceed the travel budget limits, which was approved by the Executive agency. Please refer to the table below for travel budget limits for each partner organization.
- Reimbursement of travel costs will be done upon presentation of all (including return tickets) original tickets, receipts/invoices and boarding passes. Name of the passenger, price, currency, date of purchase should be clearly visible in all





documents to be considered for reimbursement. Please remember to bring the original invoice – there will be no reimbursement without the original invoice.

- If a participant is planning to arrive early or depart, please consult with us prior to booking the tickets to make sure it is in the limits of the funder's requirements, otherwise we may not be able to provide full reimbursement. Usually one day before and one day after the event is acceptable.
- Participants planning to travel from/to another country other than the one they represent in the YE need to check with us prior to the training course, as otherwise we may not be able to reimburse their travel costs.
- Reimbursement transferred by bank account will be done in EUR regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket, receipt or invoice. Any ticket purchased in local currency other than EUR will be converted and calculated according to the exchange rate of the day the contract was signed when the ticket was purchased according to official European Commission website http://ec.europa.eu/budget/inforeuro/index.cfm?Language=en
