We are very happy to invite you to apply for our training course "Newcomers in Erasmus Plus - Preparing for Quality Mobility Projects". Please check the information and if interested apply to participate by **28 February** the latest.

Dates and place: 19-26 April 2015 in Chiari (Bs), Italy

Participants: Young leaders or youth workers interested in to develop their knowledge and skills to write Erasmus Plus projects. We will have a small group of 18 participants and trainers all together so there will be a good opportunity to share between each other and learn intensively.

Short Summary: "Newcomers in Erasmus Plus - Preparing for Quality Mobility Projects" the project is focused on preparing youth workers to be able to develop quality mobility projects within the Erasmus Plus program. In this line we expect to have participants who are working with as project managers and youth workers together going through the process of project cycle management and as well discussing about the inclusiveness of the projects for youth with fewer opportunities.

The main aim is to develop competences of youth workers enabling them to design and implement effective Erasmus Plus mobility projects and foster social cohesion in their local communities through active involvement of local youth.

Aim of the project:

- To increase the quality of mobility projects for young people who have never been involved in non-formal learning activities
- To support inclusive project development which will ultimately increase the motivation of the youth to be active
- To provide space for networking between youth mobility providers and youth policy makers in order to support quality impact of the youth mobility projects
- To promote Erasmus Plus programme to new users of the programme and support them in adding value to the youth activities they are offering_____

Program: Accepted participants will receive in advance our planned program. Please feel free to propose any changes, we are open to change it according to our partner's wishes, if possible. Also for the programme it would be good to prepare in advance especially as during the training course we will work to put our skills and ideas in practice. The programme starts on the 19th April just after lunch and finishes on 26th April.

The venue: The program will take place at Chiari (Bs), Italy. The closest airport is Milan Bergamo (http://www.sacbo.it/Airpor/portalProcess.jsp) but also other airports in the area might be a good point to arrive in Italy and then take a train. We will provide an info-kit with travel and accommodation details to the accepted participants.

Financial issues: Accommodation and board will be provided by the project. Board: breakfast, lunch, dinner, coffee brakes. Travel costs will be reimbursed by the maximum amount as indicated in the distance calculator of the EU depending per country: For participants from Macedonia, Romania, Croatia, Belgium, Poland and Bulgaria the limit is 275 EUR.
