During the training we will provide participants frames and tools of empathic communication & conflict transformation, that they can use first of all for their personal life, and secondly to improve their social work and engagement.


The project helps to identify the skills needed to set life goals which can raise the confidence of young participants, enhance their employability prospects, develop their communication skills, how they relate with themselves & others and will lead to a more fulfilling, higher quality life. Plan to make relevant, positive and effective life choices and decisions for their future to enable personal empowerment.

MAIN AIMS & OBJECTIVES

- To stimulate the self-development process of the participants;
- To increase employability and participation of youth workers, develop their professional skills and increase their efficiency;
- To give the tools of coaching and supporting the youngsters in own communities;
- To assist them to "get out of the box", enlarge their "comfort zone", maximize their creativity and see them as a possibility;
- To give the tools of empathic communication and conflict transformation for their daily life and work;
- To get intercultural experience by meeting with the representatives of different countries, cultures, backgrounds, religions, practice tolerance and break stereotypes & prejudices;
- To build partnership and future cooperation on the basis of this project under Erasmus+:
- To improve the quality of local and international youth work.

PROJECT COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENT

Cultural presentation: There will be cultural evenings organized during the TC where all the countries will present their culture (dances, songs, and typical food). You will have to prepare the cultural presentation together with other participants from your country. We ask you to make it interactive (involving the public): you can make a quiz, organize competitions, play typical games, teach a dance or a song, etc.

You **cannot use** projector for presenting presentations, maps, or kitchen for preparing food.

Extra days: If you want to arrive a day earlier or/and stay a night longer, it is possible (you have only two extra days to stay out of the project). This extra nights are on your expenses. Participants have 2 extra days to stay out of project dates.

Wireless internet connection is available in the hotel

The **training methodology** is based on learning by doing, on developing and challenging individuals and groups through a creative stimulation that connects objective contents with personal experience and internalization. They work with learning methods that follow the natural human behavior, which works in the same way like learning to walk, taste, feel. It is called learning by experience. The participants are engaged intellectually, emotionally, socially, spiritually, and physically in the training.
