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ABOUT THE PROJECT

“VALUE: Volunteering Activism for Loving and United Europe” Training Course by Erasmus+ will be implemented from the 2nd until the 10th of September 2023 by European Ways organization in Dresden, Germany. The project will include 30 participants, youth workers, out of which two will be experienced trainers from European Ways who will facilitate the training course. The participants will be coming from Bulgaria, Cyprus, Germany, Italy, Lithuania and Spain, they will be youth-workers who implement volunteering projects in their organizations, or who want to learn about volunteer management so their organizations can start implementing volunteering projects.

We want to implement this project because of the increased need among young people from Europe to take part in volunteering projects, but many NGOs are still not sure to include (international) volunteers in their work as they lack the skills and competences on how to implement those activities so they are beneficial for the volunteers, the organizations and the communities. Since we are an organization with a big experience in local and international volunteering, we want to share that knowledge with other organizations, help them grow their capacity, and ultimately create more better-quality volunteering projects and programs around Europe.





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LOCATION

You can reach the venue by train or long -distance bus as follows: Dresden-Hbf or BF Dresden-Neustadt (cheaper). In both cases tram 11 towards Bülau (final station). From there by bus 61 towards the television tower. Rochwitzer Weg/Pappritz stop. Cross street into the Rochwitzer Weg. Then turn right into the street Friedens. After approx. 100 m turn right again into the Wachwitzer Höhenweg - again after about 100 m the Hans and Sophie Scholl Haus (a total of approx. 6 minutes footpath, alternatively to the end of the television tower. There in the Wachwitzer Höhenweg: approx. . 8 minutes footpath.)

The participants will stay in 2, 3 or 4 bed rooms. Each room is equipped with its own shower/toilet. The cooking will be organized together with participants.

Preferably people who are involved in youth work, can be without prior international experience.

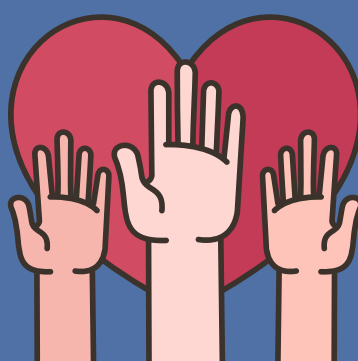
Language:
