Welcome to the project "Social Justice Club", where 25 youngsters from five different countries will learn together in a seven days-long exchange in the beautiful town of Druskininkai, Lithuania.

This infopack provides all the necessary information about the project and will be a central piece of it. Read it carefully!

The project

Join us in this journey to the depths of the concept of social justice! What is it, where does it come from, what does it mean in practice, and how do we apply it in real life?

Even though the idea of social justice appears everywhere, from political discourses to philosophy to conversations with a neighbor, it is not always easy to define what it actually means.

In this project, we will get to the very core of the concept, learning about how it came to represent different things for different people, how it guides so many of our ideals and how to turn it into an effective drive for building a better society.

Join us for this exchange in Lithuania to spend a week with 25 participants from five different countries and explore what social justive means to us.

Language used

The activities of the project will have English as the main communication language. It is therefore a participation requisite to have an English level good enough to be able to follow the activities and actively engage in them.



Young people interested in learning more about social justice. In order to be eligible for participation, you must:

- Be 18- 30 years old.
- Be a resident in one of the partner countries (Lithuania, Greece, Bulgaria, Italy and Spain).
- Have good English skills.
- Be in possession of a European Health Insurance Card or equivalent.
- Agree to the rules & terms of the project as detailed in the learning contract and sign and send it on time.



- Accommodation, food and activities' materials: 100% covered by the Erasmus+ Programme.
- Travel costs: The travel from your hometown to Druskininkai and back is covered by the project budget up to a limit. This limit is set by the Erasmus+ Programme rules and calculated using the Erasmus+ Distance Calculator tool. Maximum travel budgets are:

These are the maximum amounts the project budget will refund you for your displacements from your hometown to Druskininkai and back. If you spend more than the maximum budget, we will not be able to refund you the difference. Please note that there are some **important things** about the travel budget:

- Only the actual costs will be refunded. The project organizers will refund you no greater amount of money than the one you actually spent on the travels. If there is any margin between the costs of your tickets and the maximum travel budget, it will not be refunded.
- We can only reimburse travel costs for which original tickets/ invoices/ boarding passes are provided. We strongly recommend you to keep all the original travel documents with you, since we will not be able to refund them if we do not receive them.
- Only public transportation will be refunded. Private cars, taxis and the like will not be refunded.
- Reimbursement will be done after the exchange and will be conditioned to the compliance with the Erasmus+ Programme rules. It means that full engagement in the activities of the exchange is a requisite for the reimbursement.
- Accommodation in Druskininkai will be provided by the project organizers from November 2nd. Dinner will also be provided on that day.
- You can stay in Lithuania for up to two extra days before and after the project. In case you want to visit Lithuania or if the itinerary suits you better this way, you can come up to two days before the beginning of the exchange and/or stay up to two days after its end. Accommodation and food will not be provided by the project organizers on those days, but travel costs will still be reimbursed.

How to reach Druskininkai

The best way to arrive to Druskininkai is from **Vilnius or Kaunas**. These cities are usually well connected with other European capitals. If you do not have a possibility to take a direct flight, you can also look for the flights to Warsaw or Ryga and then take a bus. Depending on where you are departing from, you may need to take a connection flight. Usual connection hubs are Warsaw, London, Milan, Stockholm, all with convenient flights to Lithuania.

Transfer from Vilnius or Kaunas airports to bus stations can be done by regular city buses. Buses stop at the airport and arrives at Vilnius/Kaunas Bus Station (Autobusu Stotis).

Once in Vilnius/Kaunas, you can take a bus to Druskininkai. Lithuanian bus schedules and ticket reservations are available via <u>www.autobusubilietai.lt</u> Depending on the arrival times of the participants, the organizers may arrange the transportation to the accommodation.

More detailed information on how to reach the venue and the exact bus schedules will be provided later on.

Activities will begin on November 3rd at 09:00 and finish at 19:00 on December 9th. You must be in Druskininkai between these two hours. Accommodation and food will be provided at Bilso sodyba from December 2nd evening till the end of the exchange.


